Christina Winn is the Executive Director of the Prince William County Department of Economic Development and Tourism, where she leads the county's strategy for business investment, redevelopment, job growth, and tourism. Since 2019, she has helped position Prince William County as a standout in the Greater Washington, D.C. region, advancing opportunities in key industries such as life sciences and biotech, logistics, and government contracting while also strengthening the county's tourism and visitor economy.

Under her leadership, the department has generated more than \$22 billion in capital investment and supported the creation and retention of 9,829 jobs. She has been a foundational member of the Nexus234 Innovation District partnership since 2023, aimed at attracting research-driven companies and shaping long-term economic opportunity. Christina has earned recognition from the Washington Business Journal, Northern Virginia Magazine, and Virginia Business Magazine, and holds degrees from Johns Hopkins University and Arizona State University.
